Rick Prince gave a report on the 3900 block of Burgundy. A public hearing open to comments will be held by the HDLC on 25 November at 12:30 p m.

John Andrews spoke about the status of the CZO. He noted that the Floor to Area Ratio (FAR) in the CZO was possibly changed or being considered for a change to a higher density. It would be raised from one to two with a bonus of 1.5 and possible height bonus as well. This would be very dense indeed, similar to downtown Paris or Venice.

Officer Franklin announced a fundraiser for the NOPD and handed out flyers. The fund is to cover unpaid medical and loss of income for officers. A class of new officers is to graduate in December and another class is about to begin.
